Exams In NetMath

- All exams will be held online.
- All exams have scheduled exam dates. <u>Any conflicts</u> with posted exam dates must be cleared with instructors immediately upon registration.
- Courses may have two or three midterm exams and one final exam.

Necessary Materials (for all exams)

- Computer with internet connection.
- Blank sheets of paper (approximately 15 sheets) with your name, course number, and page number printed across the top of each page.
- Writing utensils (preferably black or blue pen, but dark pencils are also acceptable).

- Phone/Mobile Device capable of capturing images/scanning documents; or a scanner with email capabilities.
- Photo Identification Card (acceptable IDs include driver's license, school ID, state ID card, passport, etc.; no U.S. Military ID cards can be used due to photocopy restrictions).
- Please note: You will **not** need a calculator. The use of calculators is not permitted while taking NetMath exams.



Creating Your Gradescope Account (241, 347, 416, 417, 441 & 444)

To set up your account:

- 1. You will be sent an invitation to your @illinois.edu address
- 2. Follow the link to set your password.
- 3. Once you login you will be able to see your exams.

Taking Your Midterms (241, 347, 416, 417, 441 & 444)

- On the date of your midterm, you will log into your course at: https://learn.illinois.edu/
- Exams begin at either 10am CDT or 9pm CDT. Once you open the exam, you must complete it.
- To access the exam, select the link on your Moodle course page and follow the instructions to connect to Record+.
- Your exam will be a viewable PDF. You will not print or download your exam.

- Write your solutions on the blank sheets of paper. Only write on one side of each page.
- Once you have completed your exam or time has ended, you will need to upload your solutions to Gradescope.
- Using your mobile phone, create a PDF of your exam solutions.
- Upload instructions will be provided in your course.



Final Scheduling With ProctorU (241, 347, 416, 417, 441 & 444)

- Final exams for all courses will be held on Friday, August 8, 2025 unless your course states otherwise.
 - If your course uses ProctorU for the final: To secure your slot, follow the ProctorU invitation that will be emailed to you.
 - Schedule your reservation within the timeframe of your course
 - Be sure to select the exam SU25
- A few minutes before the start of your exam, log into the ProctorU page for your exam to check-in with your proctor.
- Your proctor will then direct you to your student dashboard, and they will enter a password.
